Jason Sandel is Executive Vice President of Aztec Well Family of Companies in Aztec, New Mexico. Sandel, a native of Farmington, is the third generation of his family to help lead a business that includes five oil and gas vertically integrated businesses, which have operated in New Mexico since 1963. He also has served on the Farmington City Council, as chairman of the New Mexico Oil and Gas Association, a member of the New Mexico Economic Development Commission, a member of the New Mexico Methane Advisory Panel and a member of New Mexico's COVID Economic Recovery Council. Sandel is currently Chair-Elect for NMOGA, Co-Convener of the New Mexico Energy Transition Committee and Chairman of the Western States and Tribal Nations Natural Gas Initiative. Sandel is a graduate of the University of New Mexico. He is married to Stacy and they have two children—Stella and Jasper.
